

INDIANA WING ENCAMPMENT PACKING LIST

BDU/ABU

At least 1 set BDU/ABU blouses with all required insignia
At least 1 set BDU/ABU trousers
1 BDU/ABU cap
1 ABU belt
4 plain t-shirts (black for BDU, Sand for ABU)
4 pair of black boot socks
1 set boot blousing strands
1 pair of black Combat boots (well broken in)
1 set grade insignia

BLUES UNIFORM

1 short sleeve Blues uniform shirt/blouse
1 pair Blues uniform pants/skirt
1 blues belt (blue belt with nickel buckle)
1 flight cap with proper insignia
1 pair of black low quarter (or pumps for females) uniform shoes
3 pair of black dress socks
3 white v-neck t-shirts
2 - 4 Shirt Stays (garters)

Physical Training Uniform

1 pair of athletic shoes
2 pairs of conservative black athletic shorts, hemmed (No cutoffs or bike shorts)
7 pair of white athletic socks
4 black or sand t-shirts (no graphics other than unit/encampment logo)
<NOTE: Can use same as above, so 4 total tees of same color is acceptable.>

EXTRA CLOTHING ITEMS

1 Clothes to travel in (CADETS MUST REPORT IN UNIFORM!)
1 pair swim trunks (males)
1 swimsuit - ONE PIECE (Females)
1 ANSI Class 2 safety vest or PT belt

PERSONAL HYGIENE ITEMS

1 Shower shoes
1 Personal hygiene items (deodorant, shaving supplies, comb, soap, shampoo, toothbrush & paste, etc.)
2 Shower towels, 1 hand towel, 2 washcloths
1 Comb/Brush (if needed)
1 Package of Moleskin for blisters
1 Foot Powder
1 Band-Aids
1 Sun Block (50 SPF or higher)
1 Bug Repellent
1 Any other personal hygiene items needed

MISCELLANEOUS

1 Canteen with cover and pistol belt (No other field gear)
4 pairs of undergarments
1 mesh Laundry Bag Similar to: [THIS ONE](#)
1 clear poncho
9 matching clothes hangers
1 Shoe shine kit
1 Flashlight (small) w/extra batteries
1 Pens, pencils, and notebook
1 Current CAP Membership Card

1 COPY OF INSURANCE CARD
1 12" Ruler
1 Spiral Notebook
1 Pair small scissors with rounded tip
1 Lint Roller

ITEMS YOU MAY BRING

1 Watch (not smart/cellular watch)
1 Robe
1 NO MORE THAN \$20.00 in spending money
1 Travel iron
1 Conservative make-up for females (For graduation)
1 Pre-paid post cards to write home
1 SMALL container of laundry soap ONLY if allergic to basic TIDE detergent

CONTRABAND

DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS

- Knives
- Weapons or firearms of any type.
- Alarm clocks
- Alcohol or tobacco products
- Electronic devices
- Non-CAP reading material (religious acceptable)
- Lighters, matches, or other dangerous items
- Curling irons, hot rollers
- Valuable items/jewelry
- Any item not conducive to the encampment environment, as judged by the Executive Staff

A FEW COMMENTS AND REMINDERS

- All gear will be searched during in-processing and contraband will be confiscated. Items will be returned at the end of encampment unless the item is illegal.
- ALL MEDICATION MUST BE SENT IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS AND MUST BE LISTED ON THE MEDICAL RELEASE FORM
- Please be sure to mark all property and clothing with Laundry mark described below in SHARPIE or laundry marker.
- Do not count on being able to purchase items during encampment at all
- The staff assumes no responsibility for lost, misplaced, or stolen items during the course of Encampment.
- Only Encampment and Squadron First Sergeants are authorized to wear the diamond on their insignia
- Shoulder cords will not be worn by Students
- Cadets are encouraged NOT to, but may bring cell phones. They will be stored by Encampment staff during the week and returned after graduation.
- Cadets attending NESA after encampment may bring gear and equipment required for that program, but it will be turned in at check-in, and returned at the end of encampment.
